Dear Mr. Rapstine:

I enjoyed our phone conversation today.

Enclosed are two photos. The one marked with a #1 on the back is of the ellipsoidal house under construction at the time of the photograph. This is the house you saw advertised in Cervi's Journal and is the only one of its kind that we have produced. This 26 foot diameter house cost our organization \$35,000 to manufacture. We would be willing to deliver it to your site in Amarillo for \$25,000. - the low price due to the fact that we are moving on to a new design. As I indicated to you on the phone, this house is built to be taken apart down the center line, thus producing a 13 foot over-the-road width, well within the limits of Colorado, New Mexico and Texas law. All that is required in terms of site preparation are the four concrete pads upon which this house rests.

Photo #2 is of our artist's rendering of our new "three-quarter" house. This is the house we will want to talk about for the future, since it will sell for under \$10,000 in quantities as a shell. We are currently producing our first house of this design and will want you to see it upon your next visit to Denver.

I would urge that you make a trip here shortly to see the ellipsoidal house. Once sold, there will be no more. It is the perfect answer to the needs of a land developer wishing to attract attention, and it provides an immediate advertising symbol, quickly recognized by all. In addition, it is easily transportable from site to site and requires little or no maintenance due to its fiberglass construction. The urethane foam interlining between the two fiberglass skins not only adds great structural rigidity, but provides for insulation characteristics unparalleled by any other type of construction.
